NEIGHBORHOOD VIBRANCY GRANT MINUTES
March 5, 2024

The NVG meeting was convened at the Pavilion Conference Room.
A roll call was taken.

Others in attendance: Ross Hilleary, Kevin Martin, Barbara Nichter, Dave Altman.

Summary:

The NVG committee met last night and reviewed the 37 applications with 570,798.28 funds requested.

- **They approved 29 grant applications with the intent to award \$422,265.40**
- They requested additional information/changes to six (6) grant applications
- They rejected two (2) grant applications

Twelve (12) neighborhoods requested near or the full amount ranging from landscaping, entrance way enhancement, and pond repairs. We highlighted Britton Falls who will be beautification the Thorpe Creek Path (\$20,061) and the Tanglewood neighborhood who will install new playground for 5-12 year olds (\$25,000).

Next Steps:

- Staff will make contact with all grant applicants. Confirm the 29 grants will proceed and we will move into the MOU/BOW step. We anticipate taking this to BOW on 3/26.
- Staff will work with the 6 grant applications, so they have updated information for our Q2 Meeting.

We will be working with Megan on recommendations and changes, so we make this a more streamlined process. Josh Morris is providing us with additional info on what HSE Foundation uses which he highly recommended.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:00 p.m.
