

REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS

This Request for Proposals (RFP) serves as formal solicitation for professional services required by the City of Fishers. We invite proposals from reputable consulting firms with expertise in delivering professional services aligned with the objectives of the following project:

Safety Action Plan – Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A)

The Safety Action Plan is intended for implementation within the City of Fishers to mitigate roadway and pedestrian fatalities as well as serious injuries across its multi-modal transportation network. The Safety Action Plan should cover the entire city limits while offering targeted solutions for key areas. Adherence to all stipulated components outlined by the U.S. Department of Transportation (DOT) in the <u>SS4A 2022</u> <u>NOFO</u> is mandatory, see Table 1.

Responsibilities:

- 1. Public and private stakeholder involvement including an online public survey
- 2. Collection and analysis of traffic and crash data
- 3. Creation of crash mapping tool (crash dashboard)
- 4. Compilation of Safety Action Plan including a prioritized comprehensive project list

Consultant Selection Criteria:

- 1. Prior Safety Action Plan experience
- 2. Experience of key personnel including an identified Project Lead
- 3. Ability to complete responsibilities by March 1, 2025

Proposals should include the following at a minimum:

- 1. Firm contact information, location of office performing work, and authorized representative
- 2. Firm qualifications, proposed staffing and designated Project Lead
- 3. Anticipated work to be subcontracted
- 4. Relevant past projects including successful innovative safety solutions
- 5. Proposed schedule for project development

Certification Regarding Debarment, Suspension, Ineligibility, and Voluntary Exclusion

The Consultant certifies, by submission of this proposal, that neither it nor its principals is presently debarred, suspended, proposed for debarment, declared ineligible, or voluntarily excluded from participating in covered transactions by any Federal department or agency. Where the Consultant is



unable to certify any of the statements in this certification, such prospective participant shall attach an explanation to this proposal.
