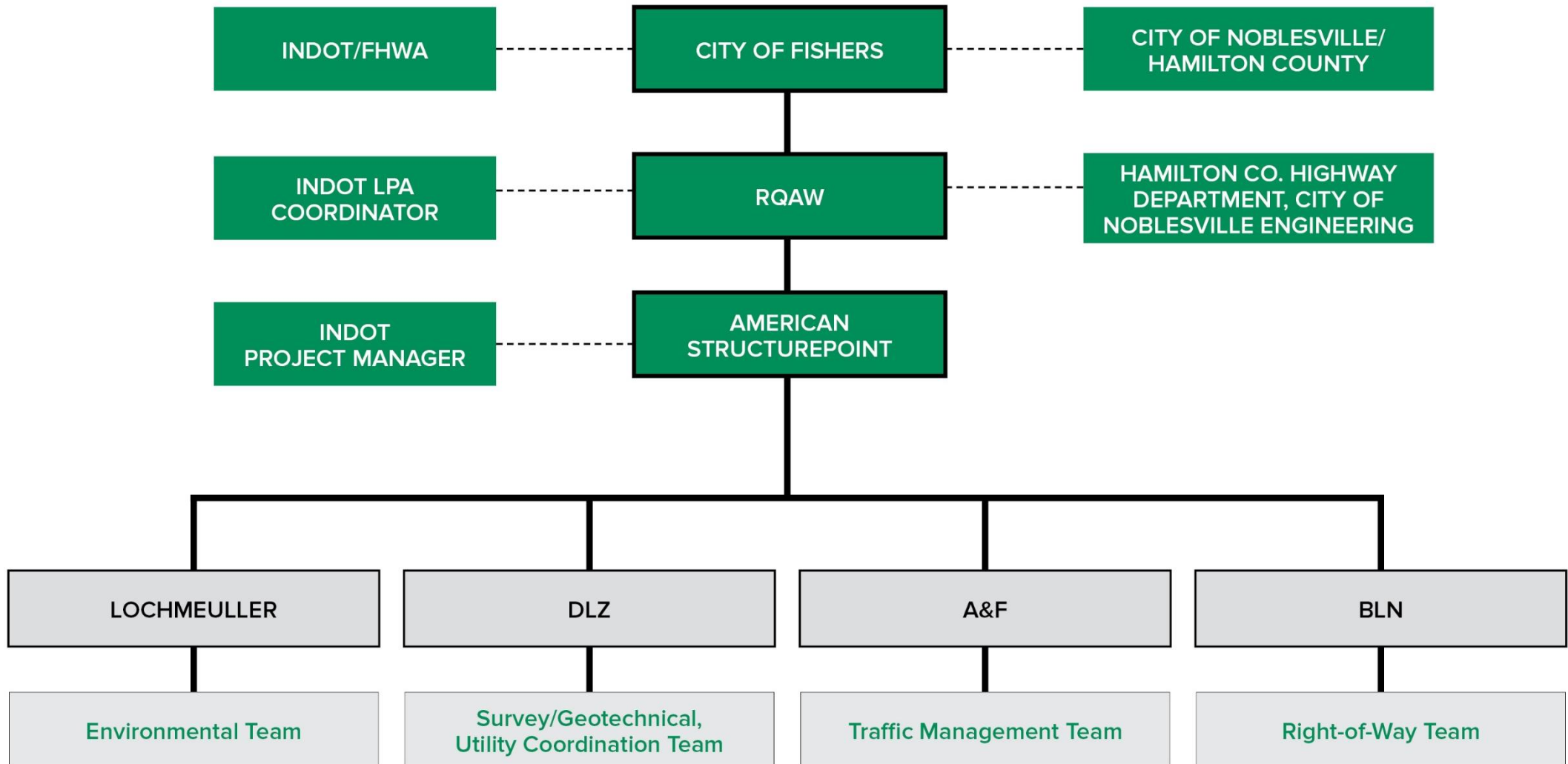
# OWNER REPRESENTATIVE ROLE RQAW

- Coordinate with all team members to ensure schedule adherence





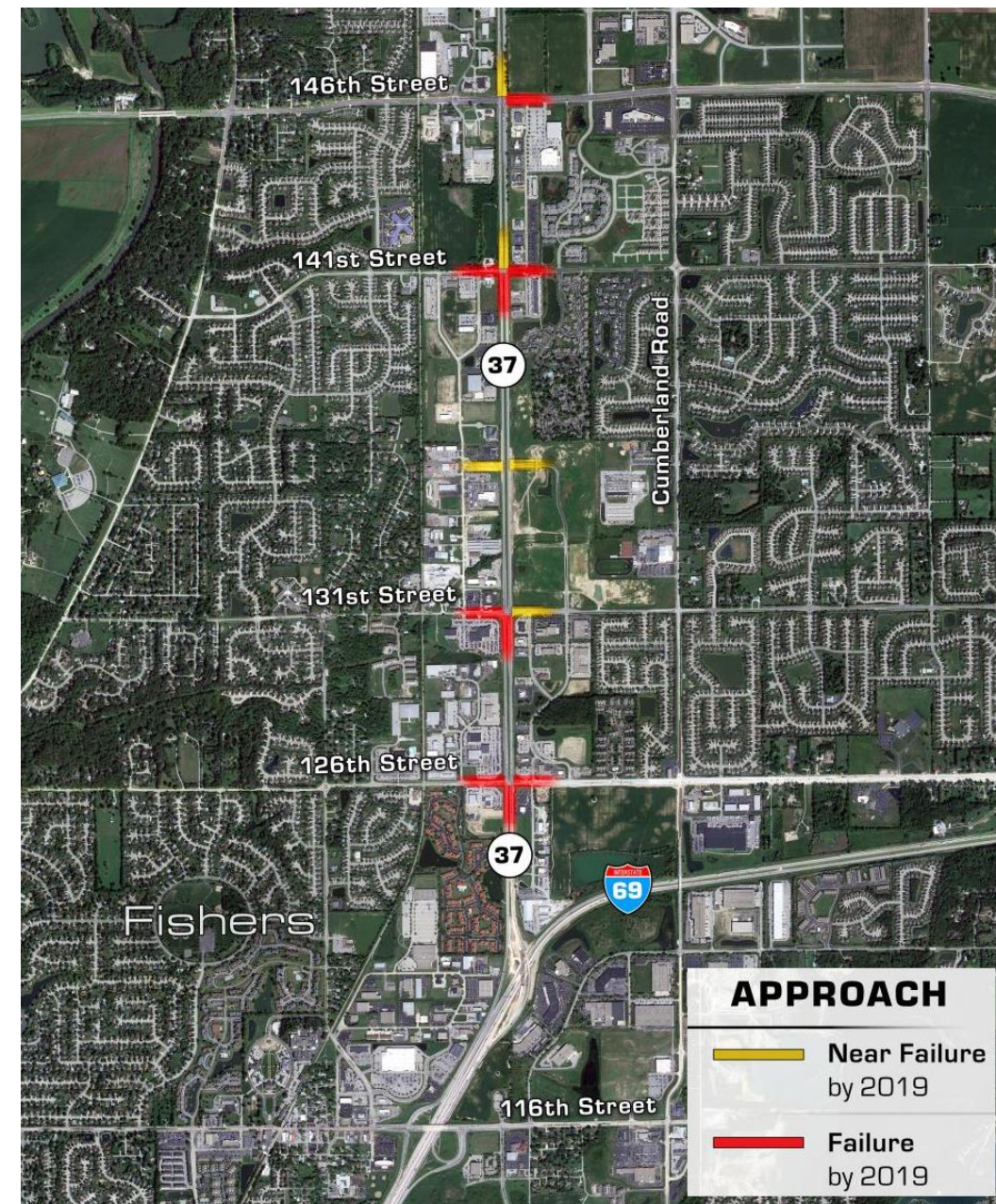
# WHY IMPROVEMENT IS NEEDED

- Unacceptable wait times on local cross streets. Residents have expressed much frustration with having to sit through multiple lights before getting across SR 37.
- Increased traffic. This means that congestion will only get worse.
- Unsafe for pedestrians and cyclist. Increased connectivity along this corridor increases quality of life.
- Congestion on adjacent roadways chosen as alternate routes to avoid congestion on SR 37.



# WHY IMPROVEMENT IS NEEDED

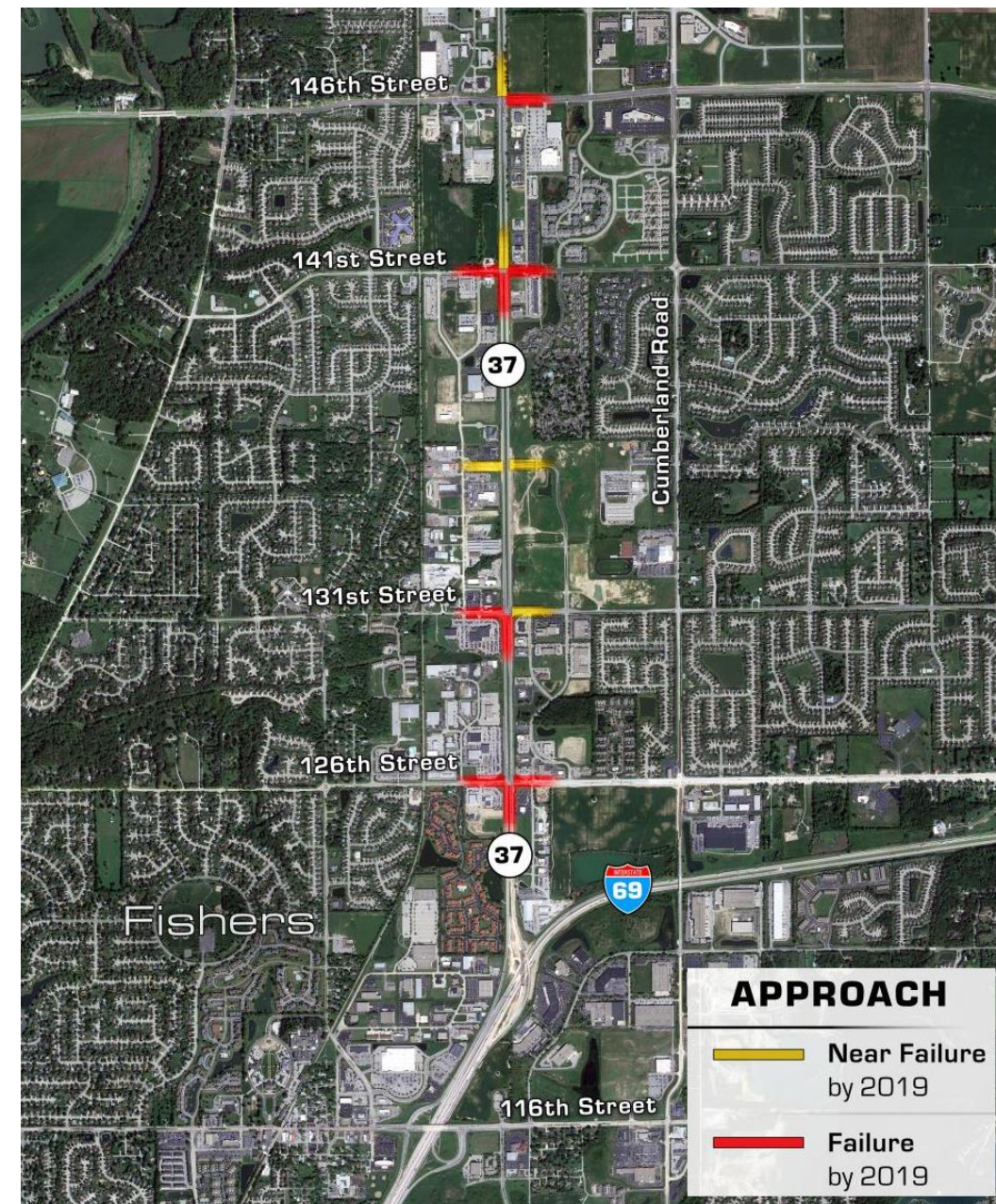
- Improve Safety For Drivers, Pedestrians & Bikers

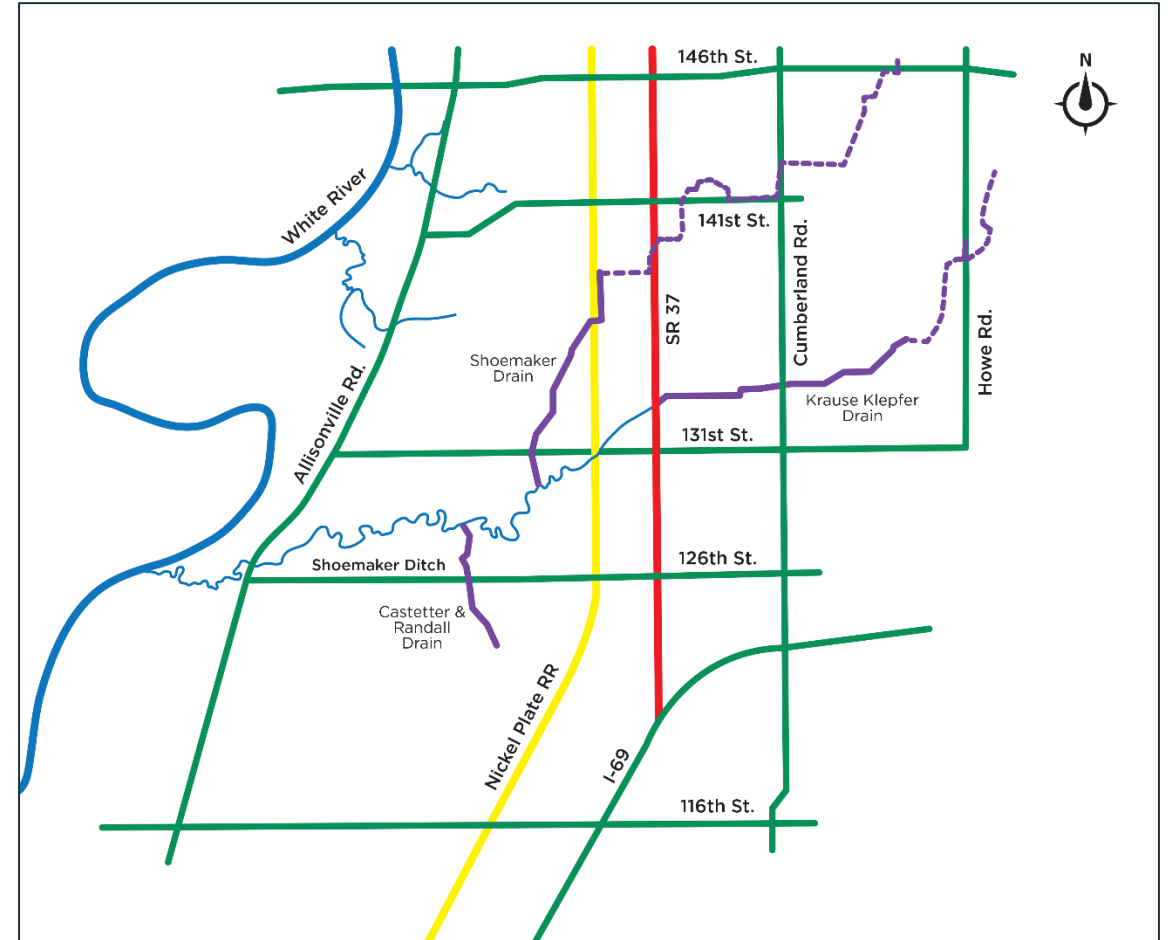

- Public outreach.



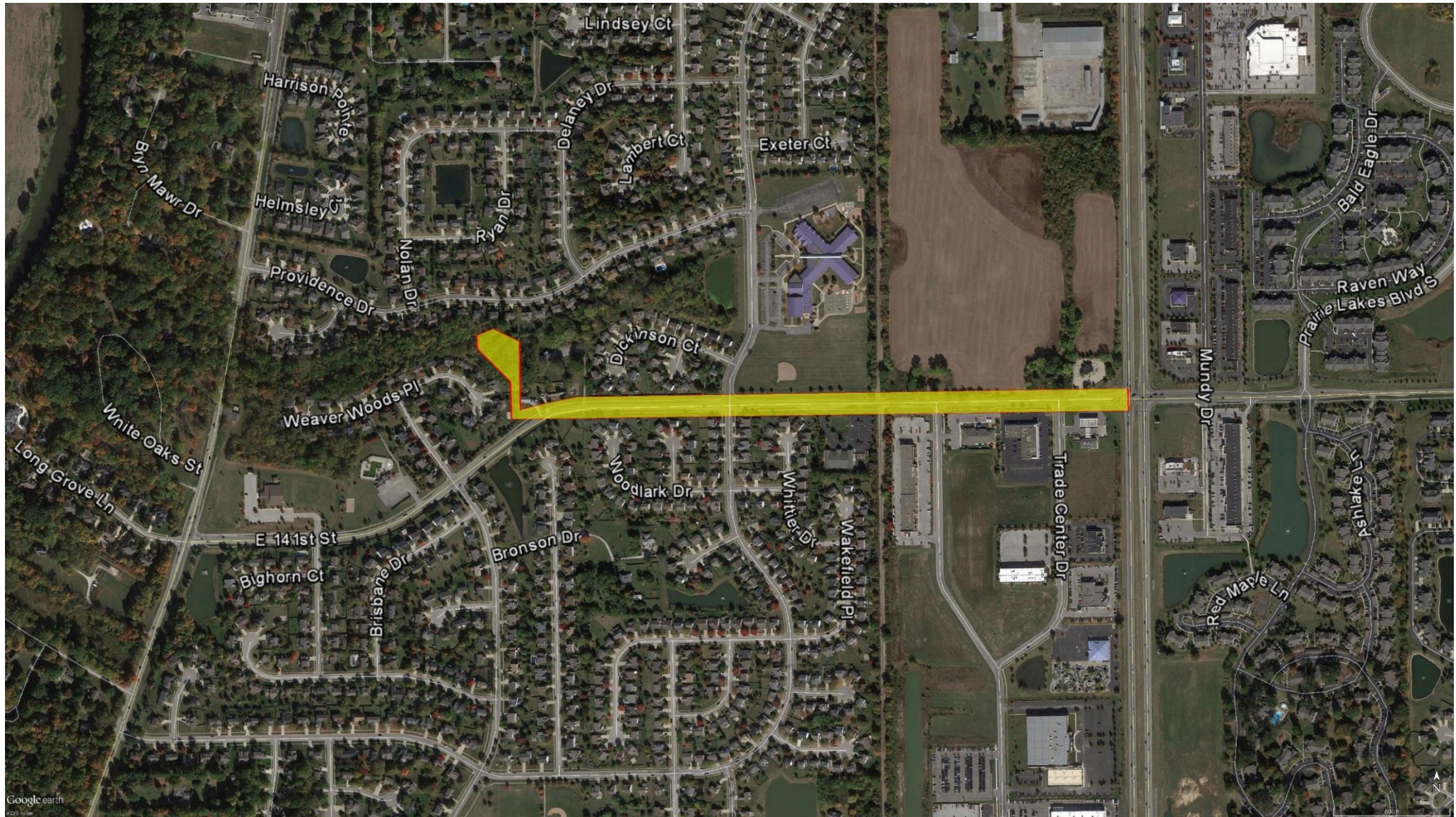
Phase I Project Limits





Southern Proposed Storm Sewer Drainage Pipe

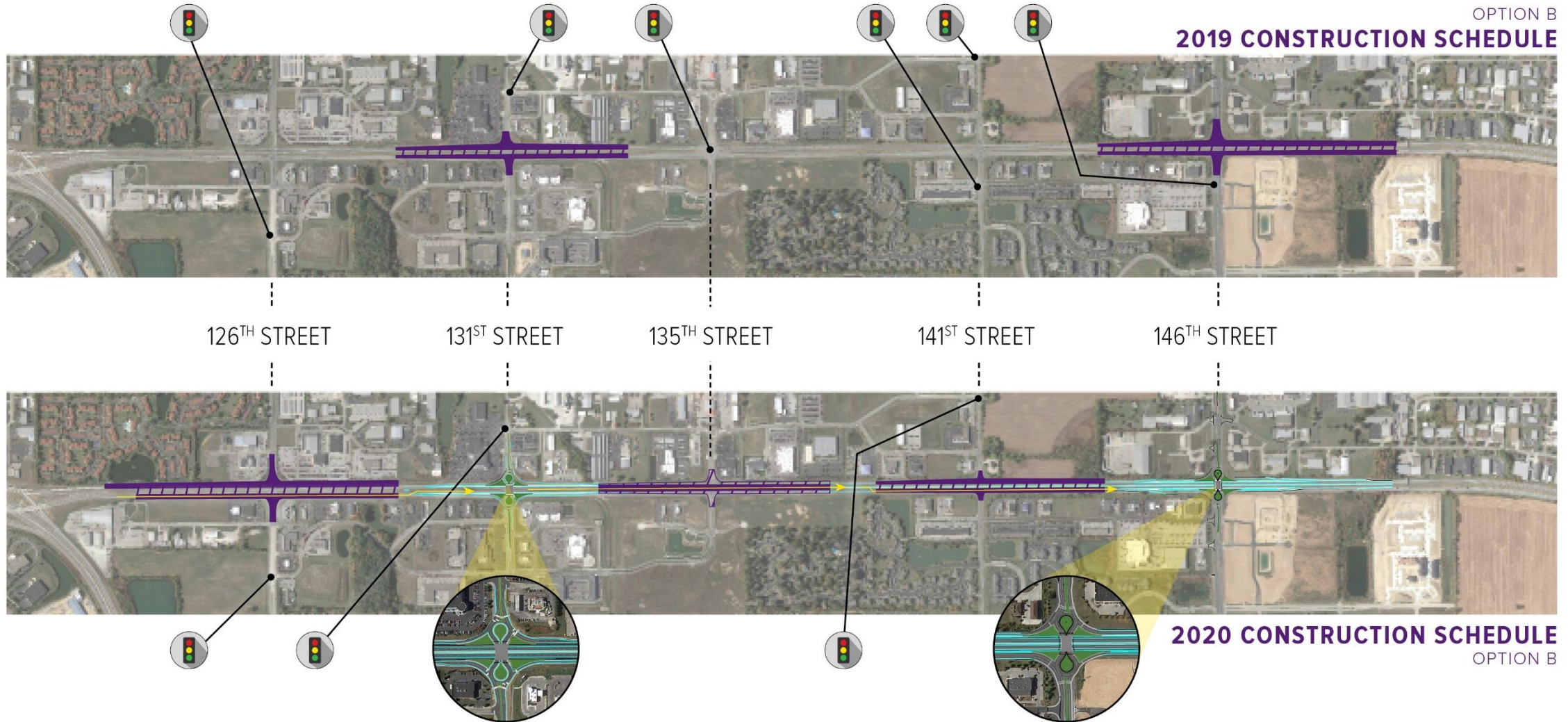




Northern Proposed Storm Sewer Drainage Pipe
