Reporting Issues

Residential Code Enforcement

This unit of the City of Fishers enforces the ordinances by acting on received complaints, researching the issues, and communicating with the involved parties thereby bringing closure to concerns or violations addressed.

Duties

The City of Fishers Department of Community and Economic Development is committed to maintaining clean, safe neighborhoods for current residents and future generations. As part of this effort, staff will proactively review properties throughout the city, ensuring each subdivision is assessed at least once per year. In addition to these routine reviews, the City will also respond promptly to concerns reported by residents.

Below is a list of common issues we monitor. If you observe any of these, we encourage you to report them.

- Dead Trees & Bushes
- Overgrown Grass & Landscaping
- Overgrown Landscaping
- Algae on Exterior
- Trash & Debris
- Non-Permitted Storage of Vehicles
- Damaged Windows, Doors, Exterior Walls, & Gutters
