Help protect your neighborhood

The City of Fishers has enacted the **Adopt-A-Fire Hydrant** program to ensure the safety of our residents and to assist the Fishers Fire Department. In the winter months heavy snowfall can bury fire hydrants, making it difficult for firefighters to locate and access them during an emergency, when every second counts.

Duties

- Keep the fire hydrant free of snow and ice with clearances of at least 3 feet all around the hydrant
- Keep the hydrant free of grass, weeds, and debris with clearances of at least 3 feet all around the hydrant
- Track hours



The City of Fishers has enacted the **Adopt-A-Storm Drain** program to improve the water quality of our streams while reducing flood risk in our community. Keeping these drains clear and free of debris prevents pollutants from entering local waterways and helps reduce localized flooding.

Duties

- Inspecting storm drains at least once per month and before forecasted heavy rains.
- Remove leaves, trash, and other debris when needed
- Track hours
