# Fishers Snow Fight

## *What to expect*

During winter weather, the City of Fishers works to keep roads and trails safe through coordinated snow and ice control operations. The Department of Public Works monitors conditions and responds using a priority system that focuses first on major roadways and emergency routes.

### Roadway Priorities

- Priority 1 – Primary Roads (Blue): Major arterials and routes connecting hospitals, police, and fire stations
- Priority 2 – Secondary Roads (Green): High-traffic feeder roads serving schools, parks, businesses, and subdivision
- Priority 3 – Subdivision Main Roads (Red): Longer roads within residential neighborhoods
- Priority 4 – Subdivision Roads (Purple): Shorter residential streets and cul-de-sacs

### Reminders for Residents

- Remove parked vehicles and basketball goals from streets to make way for snow plows
- Give snowplows plenty of space when driving – do not follow closely
- Shovel around hydrants and your home walkways to ensure they are accessible in case of emergency
