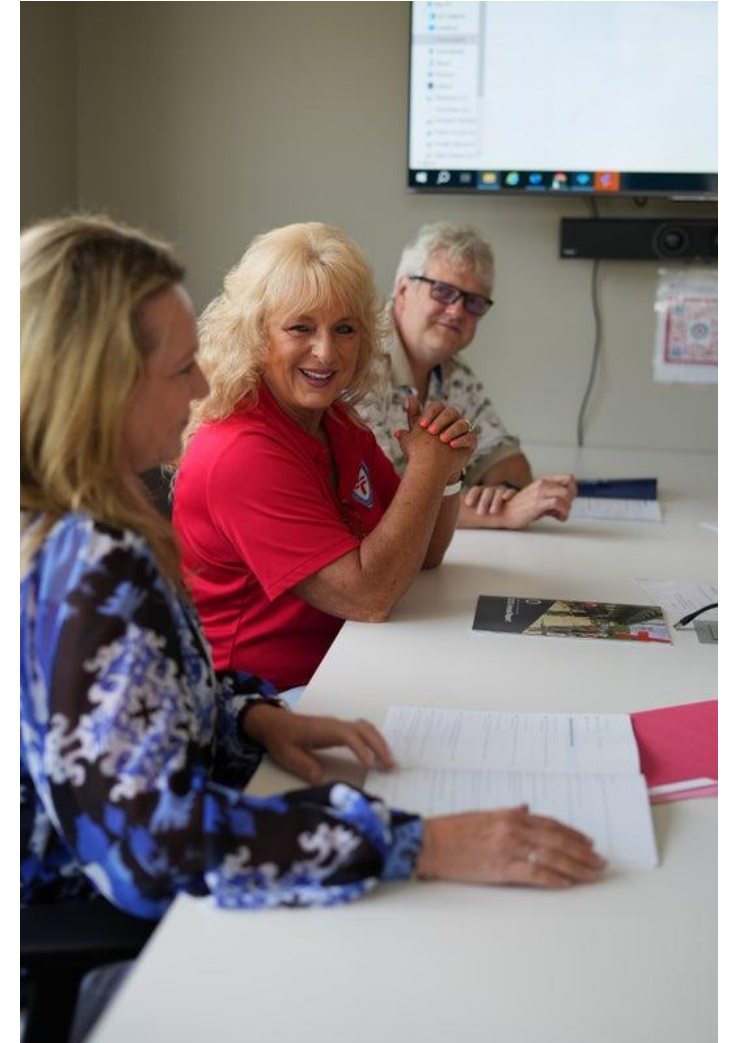

- Birth Certificates
 - Death Certificates
 - Paternity Affidavits

- Cost: \$15 (+ Coroner's fee for death)
 - For any birth or death that happened in Indiana after 1907 (if you have the right to request)
 - Online or in-person
 - Can pick up in person or we can mail it

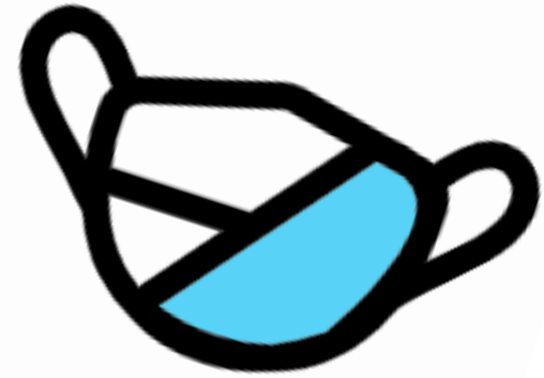

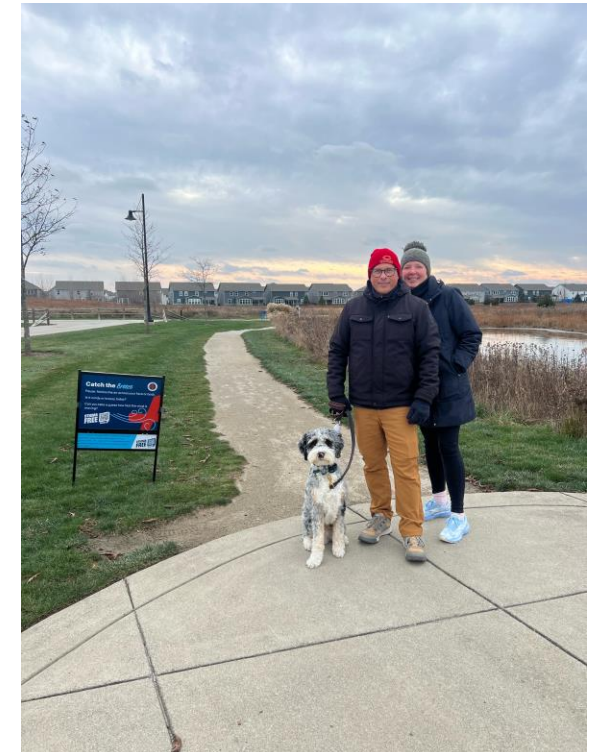
Disease Investigation

- Surveillance



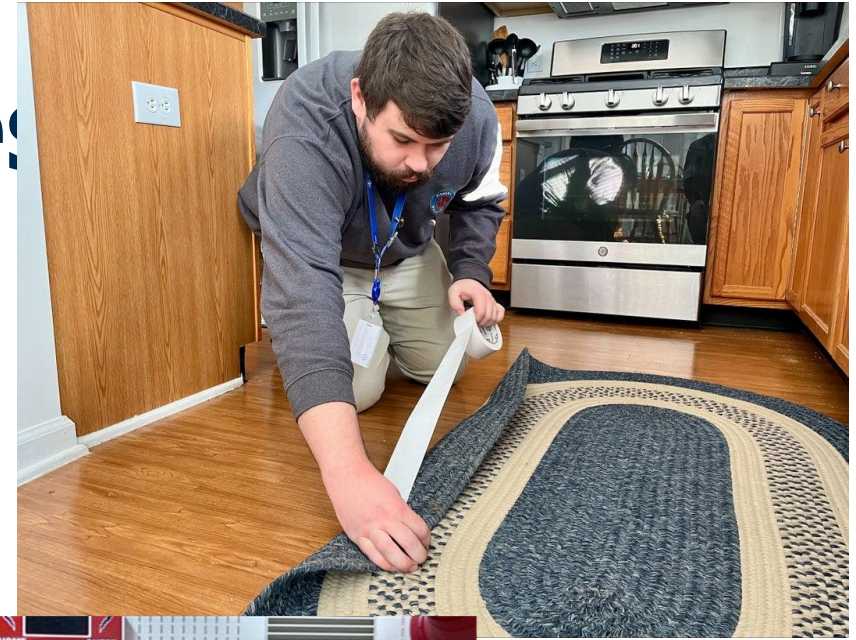

- Classes: ServSafe and CPO



Certified Pool Operator

- CPO requirements for public/semi-public pools
 - Must be on staff or contracted out
 - Certification through Pool and Hot Tub Alliance
 - Class is over 2 days; 8 hours per day
 - Learning maintenance, testing, and usage of chemicals and safety
 - Exam is taken on 2nd day
 - Cost: \$350
 - Certification valid for 5 years

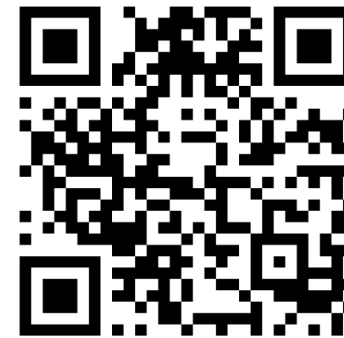
